Phi Theta Kappa University Partner Scholarships

PTK's University and four-year college partners know the value PTK members bring to their campuses—both academically, personally professionally, and socially.

Here is a breakdown of what our partners offer in scholarships exclusive to our members:

Total Number of Scholarships	879
Average Scholarship	\$4,948
Range of Awards	\$250 - \$35,000
Total Partner Scholarships (counted once)	\$4.4 Million
Awarded Scholarships Year 1 (see below)	\$338 Million
Awarded Scholarships (renewal) Year 2	\$264 Million

Calculation of Awards FY 2023

The average university partner PTK member-exclusive transfer scholarship was \$4,948¹. The calculations above are based on the number of students who indicated their goal is to transfer (71%²) and the percent of students meeting the eligibility requirements of PTK's four-year college and university partners (79%²). The second-year awards were calculated based upon the on-time BS degree completion rates of PTK members (79%³). PTK's annual membership for the 2023 cohort was 122,000 members.

Year 1 Calculation Total: \$338 Million

(calculated as percent of members eligible x members x dollars)

Year 2 Calculation Total: \$264 Million

(calculated as percent of members renewing PTK scholarship for year 2)
